14-year-old Michigan Jr. Pro Snowboarder Brian Rice II, known as 'FlyinBrian,' is chasing his dream to compete in the 2022 Olympics. Brian placed 3rd in the 2019 United States of America Snowboard and Freeski Association (USASA) National Overall competition earning an invitation to US Project Gold Camp where he trained with the US Olympic Snowboard Coaches. Brian would be the first African American snowboarder to make the US Olympic team.

The 2019-2020 season will be Brian's 2nd season training as a full time athlete on the elite team at Ski and Snowboard Club Vail (SSCV). Known for his spins and flips, Brian's trick arsenal includes a back-side double 1260, front-side 1080, switch-back 1080, switch-front-side 1080, double wildcat, crippler and is working on his triple flips. Brian is now competing in the Futures/Rev Tour, the pipeline for the US Olympic Rookie Team.

Biography

At age 4, Brian began snowboarding in his front yard ditch and his family started taking him and his sister up north to get on the bigger slopes. In elementary, he formed the Hillside Husky Ski Club to get more children involved in snow sports. At age 10, Brian began competing in the USASA-GLSS (Great Lakes Snow Series), earning his first invite to the 2015-2016 USASA Nationals. The next year, Brian won the Woodward Rider Progression Award and competed in his first all-around competition (SlopeStyle, Halfpipe, Boardercross, Giant Slalom and Slalom) at the 2016-2017 USASA Nationals.

Ranked #1 in Michigan, at the 2017-2018 USASA Nationals, Brian finished with an impressive 12th in the all-around. Based on his remarkable progression with Coach 'Dad' Brian Rice Sr. on Michigan speed

bumps, Ski and Snowboard Club Vail (SSCV) presented Brian with a full-time athlete training program for the next season to come to Vail's next level world-class training program. SSCV Coaches Ronnie Barr and Chris Laske had previously coached Brian at the Woodward Copper Camp (Summer 2017) and Wakeboarding (Summer 2017) and recognized his potential.

Last year at age 13, Brian packed his bags and headed to Vail for the 2018-2019 season. Brian lived at Copper Mountain for 6 months and competed in the USASA- Rocky Mountain Series reaching the podium in the all-around at USASA Nationals. In April, SSCV joined the USSA High Performance Center Partnership Program and Brian will continue full-time training with SSCV for the 2019-2020 season while enrolled in 9th Grade VLAC (Virtual Learning Academy Center) online school.
